

KNITTED MUG COSY

designed by Pamela Hook

Skill Level: Experienced

Time required: 2 hours

You will need:

20g DK yarn

1 button

4mm knitting needles

4mm cable needle

Tapestry needle

Scissors

Instructions:

Cast on 21 stitches

Row 1: P3, *K6, P3, rep from * to end

Row 2: K3, *P6, K3, rep from * to end

Row 3: P3, C6B, P3, C6F, P3

Row 4: repeat Row 2

Row 5: repeat Row 1

Row 6: repeat Row 2

These 6 rows form the pattern - repeat 14 times

Row 85: cast off 5, K3, P3, K6, P3 (16 stitches)

Row 86: cast off 5, P3, K3, P4 (11 stitches)

Row 87: K4, P3, K4

Row 88: P4, K3, P4

Repeat rows 87 and 88 twice

Row 93: K5, cast off 3, K3

Row 94: P4, cast on 3, P4

Row 95: K4, P3, K4

Row 96: P2tog, P2tog, K3, P2tog, P2tog (7 stitches)

Row 97: K2tog, P3, K2tog (5 stitches)

Cast off



To make up the mug cosy, sew the top and bottom of each edge together, leaving a large gap for the mug handle. Sew the button in position.

The mug cosy fits a straight sided mug, 9cm in height with a 30cm circumference. The pattern can be adapted to fit another size by adding or removing stitches.
