



Terms and Conditions for a Heart Research UK charity place in the TCS London Marathon 2022

By accepting a Heart Research UK charity place for the 2022 TCS London Marathon you are agreeing to:

1. Pay a non-refundable registration fee of £75
2. Raise a minimum of £1,850 in sponsorship (not including Gift Aid)
3. Complete the necessary registration (via an online registration link) with the London Marathon organisers when directed to by Heart Research UK, agreeing at that point to the event terms and conditions
4. Inform Heart Research UK immediately if you are no longer able to take part in the event. Please note that if you do need to withdraw from the event, your place will not automatically be deferred to the following year and you may need to re-apply.
5. Take part in the Marathon at your own risk, fully preparing yourself for the physical challenge of the event and consulting your doctor to ensure that you are medically fit to participate if necessary
6. Allow Heart Research UK to use your name, photograph, video and any comments or feedback in any future publicity, fundraising materials and/or promotion. If you do not wish your name and image to be used in this way, you will let Heart Research UK know

In fundraising for Heart Research UK you agree to:

1. Regularly pay any money collected on behalf of Heart Research UK directly to the Heart Research UK team by:
 - a. Using a fundraising website such as www.justgiving.com or www.virginmoneygiving.com
 - b. Donating online via the Heart Research UK website
 - c. Calling the Heart Research UK team on 0113 234 7474 with credit or debit card details
 - d. Sending cheques made payable to Heart Research UK to Heart Research UK, Suite 12D, Joseph's Well, Hanover Walk, Leeds, LS3 1AB
2. Return all used and un-used sponsor forms to Heart Research UK in order for us to process any Gift Aid claims
3. Pay in final sponsorship money to Heart Research UK no later than one month after the event. If you have not reached your sponsorship target by that date, you will need to agree a plan with Heart Research UK to either raise or donate the remaining funds
4. Comply with any fundraising guidance or advice issued by Heart Research UK
5. Use only lawful means to fundraise for Heart Research UK and not do anything that is likely to harm the charity's reputation

6. Not fundraise using the following methods:
- a. Carrying out door-to-door or unsolicited collections
 - b. Collecting in any public place without first obtaining authorisation from the local authority and any other licences or consent needed
 - c. Collecting on any private property (including shops, pubs etc) without first obtaining the permission of the owner
 - d. Conducting any raffle or lottery without first contacting Heart Research UK and abiding by any advice or guidance issued

You also agree that Heart Research UK can terminate your authority to fundraise at any time and/or withdraw your Heart Research UK charity place if necessary.

You must be at least 18 years old on the day of the event.

You agree that the event organisers, sponsors, or any person involved in the organisation of the event shall not be liable for any injury, accidents, loss or damage suffered by you in, or by reason of the event, however such may be caused.
